Songs that Make the Road Dance

Linda O'Brien-Rothe, 2015-08-01 An important and previously unexplored body of esoteric ritual songs of the Tz utujil Maya of Santiago Atitl n Guatemala the Songs of the Old Ones are a central vehicle for the transmission of cultural norms of behavior and beliefs within this group of highland Maya Ethnomusicologist Linda O Brien Rothe began collecting these songs in 1966 and she has amassed the largest and perhaps the only significant collection that documents this nearly lost element of highland Maya ritual life This book presents a representative selection of the more than ninety songs in O Brien Rothe s collection including musical transcriptions and over two thousand lines presented in Tz utujil and English translation Audio files of the songs can be downloaded from the UT Press website Using the words of the songmen who perform them O Brien Rothe explores how the songs are intended to move the Old Ones the ancestors or Nawals to favor the people and cause the earth to labor and bring forth corn She discusses how the songs give new insights into the complex meaning of dance in Maya cosmology as well as how they employ poetic devices and designs that place them within the tradition of K'iche' an literature of which they are an oral form O Brien Rothe identifies continuities between the songs and the K'iche' an origin myth the Popol Vuh while also tracing their composition to the late sixteenth and early seventeenth centuries by their similarities with the early chaconas that were played on the Spanish guitarra espa'ola which survives in Santiago Atitl n as a

five string guitar *Songs to Make the Dust Dance* Yung-Hee Kim, 2024-06-21 Breaking through the long established image of Heian Japan 794-1185 as a culture dominated by ritualized aristocratic values Yung Hee Kim presents a picture of a country in transition filled with a wide variety of common people responding to very ordinary situations The court does not disappear but rather becomes part of a larger society inhabited by Buddhist nuns and mountain ascetics farmers and fishermen beggars and gamblers In popular songs called imayo they express their concerns about religion love aging and even current affairs In 1179 Emperor Go Shirakawa compiled a collection of this song genre which had flourished for two centuries His twenty volume anthology Ryojin hisho circulated until the middle of the fourteenth century when it disappeared completely To the astonishment of the scholarly world two volumes reappeared early in the twentieth century It is these texts a small remnant of a powerful popular literature that Kim makes accessible to English speaking readers Ryojin hisho juxtaposes the sacred with the profane the high with the low the male with the female the old with the new The songs in translations that faithfully reflect the sounds and images of the originals make up the core of this book They are surrounded by a wealth of material on the imayo genre the women who sang the songs the role of court patronage and other aspects of Heian culture Far from simply surviving as an aesthetic artifact the anthology comes to life in its own literary and cultural context This title is part of UC Press's Voices Revived program which commemorates University of California Press's mission to seek out and cultivate the brightest minds and give them voice reach and impact Drawing on a backlist dating to 1893 Voices Revived makes high quality peer reviewed scholarship accessible once again using print on demand technology This title was originally published in 1994 *Folk and Songs in Japan and Beyond* Matt Gillan, Kiku Day, Patrick Huang, 2022-05-10 This volume of essays and research papers is dedicated to David Hughes in honour of his contribution to research teaching and dissemination of the music of Japan South East Asia and other countries over many years Dr Hughes' academic output from the 1970s to the present has covered many aspects of Japanese traditional music making in particular the min'yō folk song genre of which he remains the primary scholar outside Japan His groundbreaking work has also encompassed theories of musical grammars oral notation systems in cross cultural perspective as well as several papers on cultural heritage and preservation societies The contributors to this volume comprise many of David's former students as well as scholars from Japan and elsewhere with whom Dr Hughes has collaborated over the years The papers reflect the depth and breadth of Hughes' research output demonstrating his continuing influence over ethnomusicologists around the world **Hitler's Twilight of the Gods** Alexandra Birch, 2025-02-28 Music was an integral part of statecraft and identity formation in the Third Reich Structured thematically and semiotically around the Wagnerian tetralogy of the Ring cycle Hitler's Twilight of the Gods provides a sonic read of the Second World War and the Holocaust Alexandra Birch sheds light on the specific type of music promoted under Nazism linked to larger Teutonic mythologies and histories espoused in rhetoric and personal styling The book explores the musical fixation of the command as it was extended to the ordinary
