INTRODUCTION

Bony Fishes

YELLOW PERCH (Perca flavescens)

Common Name: Yellow Perch
Scientific Name: *Perca flavescens*
Distribution: Found throughout Saskatchewan's waters, particularly in the central and northern regions.
Habitat: Prefers shallow, vegetated areas with sandy or rocky bottoms.
Characteristics: A medium-sized fish with a deep, laterally compressed body. It has a prominent dorsal fin and a long, pointed snout. The color is typically yellowish-brown with dark vertical stripes.

ROCK BASS (Ambloplites rupestris)

Common Name: Rock Bass
Scientific Name: *Ambloplites rupestris*
Distribution: Found in the southern and central parts of Saskatchewan.
Habitat: Prefers rocky, riffle areas in streams and rivers.
Characteristics: A small, deep-bodied fish with a large head and prominent scales. It has a dark, mottled pattern on its side.

WHITE BASS (Morone americana)

Common Name: White Bass
Scientific Name: *Morone americana*
Distribution: Found in the southern and central parts of Saskatchewan.
Habitat: Prefers clear, flowing water in streams and rivers.
Characteristics: A medium-sized fish with a deep, laterally compressed body. It has a prominent dorsal fin and a long, pointed snout. The color is typically silvery with a dark lateral stripe.

SPINY-TAILED NODDY (Xiphophorus birchmanni)

Common Name: Spiny-tailed Noddy
Scientific Name: *Xiphophorus birchmanni*

WATER LILY (Najas)

Common Name: Water Lily
Scientific Name: *Najas*
Distribution: Found throughout Saskatchewan's waters, particularly in the central and northern regions.
Habitat: Prefers shallow, vegetated areas with sandy or rocky bottoms.
Characteristics: A medium-sized fish with a deep, laterally compressed body. It has a prominent dorsal fin and a long, pointed snout. The color is typically yellowish-brown with dark vertical stripes.
