#### Ontology

What exists and what is "the thing" we deal with? An ontology is a specification of a conceptualization. What "exists" is that which can be represented. When the knowledge of a domain is represented in a declarative way or if it's normative, the set of objects that can be represented in called the universe of discourse.


#### Methodology
