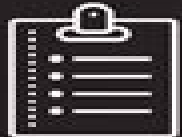


HOW TO WRITE A THESIS STATEMENT?

5. Review and Revise:

Once your essay or research paper is complete, revisit your thesis statement. Ensure it still aligns with the arguments you presented in your paper.
