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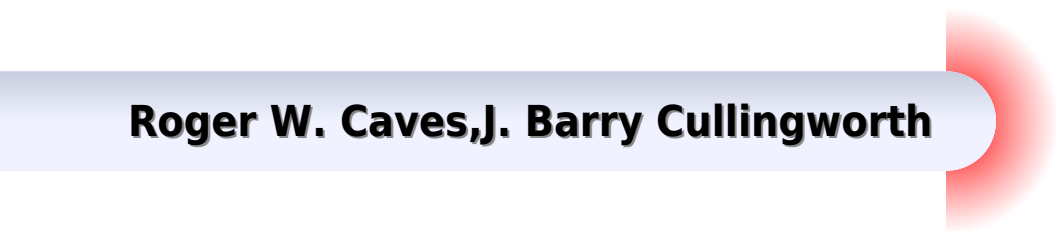

urban rural code scheme was developed by the ERS in the 1970s Rural America today is very different from the rural America of 1970 described in the first rural classification report At that time migration to cities and poverty among the people left behind was a central concern The more rural a residence the more likely a person was to live in poverty and this relationship held true regardless of age or race Since the 1970s the interstate highway system was completed and broadband was developed Services have become more consolidated into larger centers Some of the traditional rural industries farming and mining have prospered and there has been rural amenity based in migration Many major structural and economic changes have occurred during this period These factors have resulted in a quite different rural economy and society since 1970 In April 2015 the Committee on National Statistics convened a workshop to explore the data estimation and policy issues for rationalizing the multiple classifications of rural areas currently in use by the Economic Research Service ERS Participants aimed to help ERS make decisions regarding the generation of a county rural urban scale for public use taking into consideration the changed social and economic environment This report summarizes the presentations and discussions from the workshop
