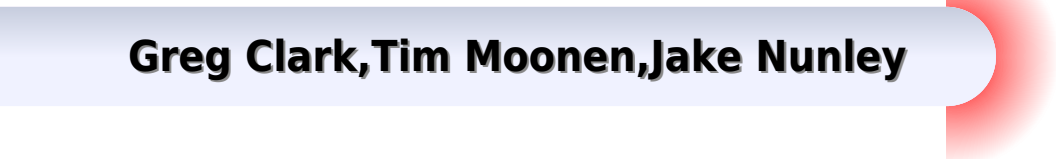

The Making of a World City Greg Clark, 2014-10-16 After two decades of evolution and transformation London had become one of the most open and cosmopolitan cities in the world The success of the 2012 Olympics set a high water mark in the visible success of the city while its influence and soft power increased in the global systems of trade capital culture knowledge and communications The Making of a World City London 1991 2021 sets out in clear detail both the catalysts that have enabled London to succeed and also the qualities and underlying values that are at play London s openness and self confidence its inventiveness influence and its entrepreneurial zeal London s organic unplanned incremental character without a ruling design code or guiding master plan proves to be more flexible than any planned city can be Cities are high on national and regional agendas as we all try to understand the impact of global urbanisation and the re urbanisation of the developed world If we can explain London s successes and her remaining challenges we can unlock a better understanding of how cities succeed

The Desecularisation of the City David Goodhew, Anthony-Paul Cooper, 2018-09-21 Major cities have long been seen as centres of secularisation However the number of congregations in London grew by 50% between 1979 and the present London s churches have been characterised more by growth than by decline in the decades since 1980 The Desecularisation of the City provides the first academic survey of churches in London over recent decades linking them to similar developments in other major cities across the West Produced by a large team of scholars from a range of disciplines this volume offers a striking and original portrait of congregational life in London since 1980 Seventeen chapters explore the diverse localities ethnicities and denominations that make up the church in contemporary London The vitality of London s churches in the last four decades shows that secularisation is far from inevitable in the cities of the future This study necessitates a significant reassessment of the dominant academic portrayal of Christianity in Britain and the West which has mostly depicted cities as secular spaces within a secularising culture It will be of great interest to scholars working across a wide range of disciplines including history sociology religious studies and theology

Migration and the European City Christoph Cornelißen, Beat Kümin, Massimo Rospoche, 2022-03-07 Looking back over the centuries migration has always formed an important part of human existence Spatial mobility emerges as a key driver of urban evolution characterized by situation specific combinations of opportunities restrictions and fears This collection of essays investigates interactions between European cities and migration between the early modern period and the present Building on conceptual approaches from history sociology and cultural studies twelve contributions focus on policies representations and the impact on local communities more generally Combining case studies and theoretical reflections the volume s contributions engage with a variety of topics and disciplinary perspectives yet also with several common themes One revolves around problems of definition both in terms of demarcating cities from their surroundings and of distinguishing migration in a narrower sense from other forms of short and long distance mobility Further shared concerns include the integration of multiple analytical
