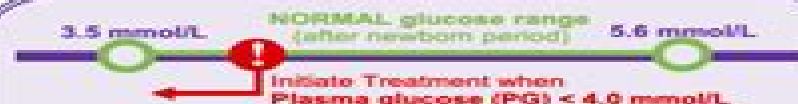




- Pathophysiology: **Autoimmune** destruction of insulin-producing **pancreatic beta cells** in the islets of Langerhans, resulting in **insulin deficiency**
- Age of presentation: Can present at any age; Bimodal distribution of peaks at 4 - 6 years old and early puberty (10 - 14 years old)
- Risk factors: both genetic (relatives with T1DM) and environmental factors
 - In **genetically susceptible individuals**, exposure to one or more **environmental agents** likely triggers immune response



RECOMMENDED GLYCEMIC TARGETS

- A1C ≤ 7.5 (7 in some guidelines); fasting PG 4.0 - 5.0 mmol/L, postprandial PG 5.0 - 10.0 mmol/L
- Pre-prandial targets of 6.0-10.0 mmol/L
- Consider higher A1C target if prior significant hypoglycemia or hypoglycemia unawareness



DIAGNOSIS

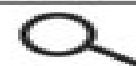
Clinical Presentation

- Polyuria**: osmotic diuresis due to increased urinary glucose excretion
 - Secondary **enuresis** or **nocturia** in children
- Polydipsia**: result of increased serum osmolality
- Polyphagia**
- Diabetic Keto Acidosis (DKA)**
- Weight loss**: due to hypovolemia, increased catabolism (impaired glucose utilization, increased muscle & fat breakdown)
- Factors that may help differentiate T1DM vs T2DM:
 - Body habitus**: Obesity is important risk factor for T2DM



Investigations

- Diagnosis of diabetes**:
 - Fasting PG ≥ 7 mmol/L
 - Random PG ≥ 11.1 mmol/L
 - PG ≥ 11.1 2 hr post 75 g OGTT (OGTT not frequently used for diagnosis in children)
 - A1C **not** used to diagnose T1DM in children
- If asymptomatic, second test always needed; single test sufficient if symptomatic
- Lab results to support T1DM vs T2DM: antibodies (e.g., GAD65), insulin, C-peptide



MANAGEMENT



Education

- Training for patients & families by **multidisciplinary teams**:
 - Insulin; BG & ketone monitoring; sick-day management; DKA; hypoglycemia; correction factors
- Anticipatory guidance
- Dietician referral
- Carbohydrate counting** to match insulin to intake, allows flexibility in diet (I:C ratio)

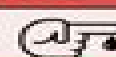
Insulin



- Treat to **meet glycemic targets**
- Two types of intensive insulin regimens: **Multiple daily injections (MDI)** & **continuous subcutaneous insulin infusion (CSII)**; insulin pump
- Less intensive BID & TID regimens
- Fingerstick or continuous glucose monitoring (CGM)
- Hypoglycemia management**:
 - Mild & moderate: oral simple carbohydrate e.g., fruit juice
 - Severe: **glucagon** (IM, intranasal, SC), IV dextrose

ACUTE COMPLICATIONS

- Hypoglycemia** (due to insulin)
- Diabetic Ketoacidosis (DKA)**



SCREENING

Check for...	Starting...	Frequency
Glycemic control (A1C)	At Dx	q3months
Autoimmune thyroid (TSH & TPO)	At Dx	q2years
Celiac & Adrenal insufficiency	-	As indicated
Nephropathy	Age 12 (if Dx >5 years ago)	Annually
Retinopathy	Age 15 (if Dx >5 years ago)	Annually
Neuropathy	Age 15 (with poor glycemic control)	Annually (after 5 years of Dx)
Dyslipidemia	Age 12 (if no extra risk factors)	Repeat at 17
Hypertension	At Dx	q6months

Microvascular Disease

- Diabetic nephropathy
- Diabetic retinopathy
- Peripheral & autonomic neuropathy

Macrovascular Disease

- Cardiac disease (CAD, MI)
- Peripheral vascular disease
- Cerebrovascular disease (stroke)
