On average, people in developed countries are better educated, healthier, and live longer than the rest of the world's population. Population growth rates in developed countries are very less—about 0.003 per capits. The populations of some of these countries, such as Russia, Germany, and Italy, are shrinking because death rates exceed birthrates.

Most people (about 30 percent of the world's population) live in developing countries, a category that includes most countries in Asia, Central America, South America, and Africa.
