- yes: is the following question an example of a sociological question? "How has globalization changed local culture"
- society: a large group of people who live in the same area and participate in a common culture
- 4. human beings are part of normally hidden social networks, in which we know people who know other people we don't know but who have much in COMMON with us (individual/personal problems tend to be social problems that EVERYONE is going through): what is BASIC sociological insight?
- Sociology: the study of societies and the social worlds that individuals inhabit within them/ study of how we live together
- social context: factors that influence a person's (mainly a child's) life. they evaluate and determine their future
- 7. "digital footprint" constant changes and developments concern/affect the relationship between individuals and their social worlds (in other words, social lives affect social worlds): explain the subject at the HEART of sociology
- 8. the making of faulty generalizations based on what we think we know about the groups: stereotypes
- sociological imagination: the capacity to think systematically about HOW many things we experienced as personal problems are really social issues that are widely shared by others living in a similar TIME and LOCATION as us
- 10. C Wright Mills: who coined the term sociological imagination
- 11. to simplify a complex world, we often assume that things around us are somehow inevitable or natural. Examples: marriage, race, and ethnicity: what basic IMPULSE does sociological imagination challenge
- 12. by raising questions about where they come from, what they are based on, who stands to benefit from them, and why they are harmful: how does social imagination challenge stereotypes
